**SUBJECT: InsulFoam EPS and RoHS**

Insulfoam, a division of Carlisle Construction Materials is a committed steward of our industry and believes in transparency, sustainability, recycling and providing pertinent information on the products we produce.

RoHS or Restriction of Hazardous Substances Directive is a European Union directive that went into effect July of 2006. This directive has been updated and the RoHS 3 has been in effect since July 22, 2019. RoHS 3 lists ten substances and the levels that require reporting. These include:

- Cadmium (Cd): < 100 ppm
- Lead (Pb): < 1000 ppm
- Mercury (Hg): < 1000 ppm
- Hexavalent Chromium: (Cr VI) < 1000 ppm
- Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB): < 1000 ppm
- Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE): < 1000 ppm
- Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP): < 1000 ppm
- Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP): < 1000 ppm
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP): < 1000 ppm
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP): < 1000 ppm

InsulFoam EPS products do not contain any of these substances and therefore comply with RoHS 3.
